

Student Right to Know Act

Under the Student-Right-To-Know-Act, Birthingway is required to report annually on the completion (or graduation) rates for certificate and degree seeking full-time students. Statistics address whether or not these students complete their program within 150% of the normal time.

Statistics cover the Midwifery Program cohort beginning their studies between September 2011 and August 2012 (2012 cohort). Statistics cover the Lactation Consultation Pathway 2 Program cohort beginning their studies between September 2012 and August 2013 (2013 cohort).

We do not currently have full-time, first-time students because all program students are required to take college-level prerequisites prior to matriculation. For this reason, in addition to the required statistics for full-time, first-time undergraduates, we have also provided statistics for all students beginning the program in this cohort.
