Name	Cost	Frequency
Application Fee	\$75	One-time. Upon application to program.
Enrollment Fee	\$200	One-time. Upon enrollment in program.
Registration Fee	\$60	Each term.
Technology Fee	\$40	Spring, fall, winter terms.
Coursepack Fees	Varies	Course-by-Course. On registration information each term.
Lab Fees	Varies	Course-by-Course. On registration information each term.
Texts/Equipment	Varies	Course-by-Course. On registration information each term.
Lunch Costs	Varies	Each term; approximately every 4-6 weeks.
Client Care Book Fee	\$30	One Time. At beginning of clinical training.
Client Care Documentation Verification	\$150	One time. Near graduation.
Oral Integration Exam Fee	\$240	One time. Near graduation.
Graduation Fee	\$100	One time. Prior to graduation process.



Payment is due at the time of registration each term, unless the student has financial aid clearance. If receiving financial aid, payment is due typically 4-6 weeks into the term.
